Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Enclosed for filing is PECO Energy Company's proposed Act 129 Conservation Service Provider ("CSP") contract with Comverge, Inc.<sup>1</sup> ("Comverge") for which PECO requests Commission review and approval. PECO procured the contract in accordance with the competitive request for proposals ("RFP") process approved by the Commission on April 13, 2016 at the above-referenced docket. PECO is seeking approval of the Comverge contract and a waiver, to the extent necessary, of the requirement in the Phase III Implementation Order that the Company obtain advance Commission approval of its competitive RFP process.

**Please note that this contract is CONFIDENTIAL and should be accorded confidential treatment by the Commission.**

PECO has selected Comverge for the provision of services in connection with the Company's Residential Demand Response Program and Small Commercial and Industrial Demand Response Program. The RFP for these services was issued on March 1, 2016 by Exelon Business Services Company and was conducted in a manner consistent with PECO's Phase III Commission-approved RFP process. The Comverge contract is consistent with the Commission's contract criteria in the Phase III Implementation Order.<sup>2</sup>



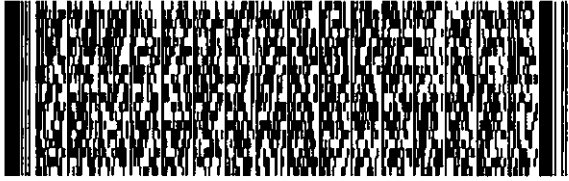
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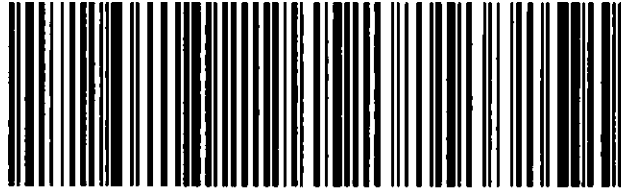
