
Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

By Secretarial Letter dated February 22, 2017, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) approved the change of the name on GDF SUEZ Energy Resources NA, Inc.’s electric generation supplier license to ENGIE Resources, LLC (“ENGIE”). In addition to approving the requested name change, ENGIE was directed to provide a notice to its customers informing them of the name change no later than thirty (30) days from the date of the Secretarial Letter, and to file a copy of the notice to customers no later than sixty (60) days from the date of the Secretarial Letter.

Although ENGIE has authorization to serve residential customers, at this time it only provides service to commercial and industrial electricity customers. ENGIE is not aware of any confusion among these customers relating to the use of the name “ENGIE” or “ENGIE Resources, LLC”. **Under these circumstances, ENGIE respectfully requests that the Commission waive the customer notice requirement included in the Secretarial Letter of February 22, 2017.**
