
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On April 3, 2017, a new bond in the amount requested by Commission staff was delivered to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to satisfy the electric generation supplier (“EGS”) security requirements of ENGIE Resources LLC (“ENGIE”) commencing April 19, 2017.
