Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

This is an informational filing made by ENGIE Resources, LLC ("ENGIE") in response to a Staff request relating to a transfer of customers in 2016 by a licensed electric generation supplier, Guttman Energy, Inc. ("Guttman") to ENGIE's predecessor in interest, GDF SUEZ Energy Resources NA Inc. ("SUEZ").

In January 2016, Guttman provided notice to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") of its intent to assign customers to SUEZ. Since that time, SUEZ has requested and received Commission approval of a name change to ENGIE Resources, LLC. Commission Staff has requested ENGIE to file at the ENGIE and Guttman dockets, certain information. This information is described below and attached to this correspondence. **ENGIE is submitting a public version of this filing and a confidential version that contains proprietary information. ENGIE respectfully requests that the confidential version of this filing be placed under seal and that the public version of this filing be placed in the public record.** ENGIE's responses to Commission Staff's informational requests are as follows.

Confidential Attachment 1 – The customers ENGIE obtained from Guttman were transferred in 2016. Therefore, ENGIE's gross revenues for the last 12 months (2016) depicted in this attachment include the revenues associated with transferred customers.

Attachment 2 – Attached is the customer notice letter submitted by Guttman to the Commission on January 6, 2016. It explains to customers that electricity supply service will be provided by SUEZ (ENGIE's name at the time) and that the terms of service will remain the same.




