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Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On March 13, 2017, Gulf Operating, LLC (“Gulf”), Philadelphia Energy Solutions Refining & Marketing, LLC (“PESRM”), Sheetz, Inc. (“Sheetz”), Monroe Energy, Inc. (“Monroe Energy”) and Giant Eagle, Inc. (“Giant Eagle”) (collectively the “Indicated Parties”) filed a Petition for Interlocutory Review requesting that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) order that data and information about Laurel’s potential plans to reverse flow easterly beyond Eldorado was relevant in the above-referenced proceeding. As explained in Laurel Pipe Line Company, L.P.’s (“Laurel”) Brief in Opposition to the Petition for Review, the Indicated Parties filed the Petition after presiding Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero (the “ALJ”) ruled that discovery requests regarding this issue were irrelevant and outside the scope of this proceeding.

While Laurel still believes that information and data about Laurel’s potential plans to reverse the flow of the pipeline east of Eldorado are irrelevant, in order to expedite this proceeding, Laurel has provided this information to the Indicated Parties. In order to avoid further delay, Laurel

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also will agree to allow the Indicated Parties to submit evidence regarding this issue into the record and will not move to strike testimony regarding this issue on the basis that it is irrelevant. Laurel notes, however, that it reserves its rights to argue in its testimony, briefs and exceptions and/or reply exceptions that this information is not relevant and that the ALJ and the Commission should not consider it when issuing their respective decisions.

Laurel's proposal, as described above, moots the Petition for Interlocutory Review. There is therefore no need for the Commission to address the Petition at this time. Rather, the Commission can address the relevance of the issue raised in the Petition when the Commission issues its Final Order in the above-referenced proceeding.

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
