On behalf of Laurel Pipe Line Company, L.P. ("Laurel" or "the Company"), this letter provides an update of individuals previously identified as witnesses in this proceeding in Laurel's Prehearing Memorandum. Laurel expects the following additional witnesses to present testimony in this proceeding:


- Mr. Scott T. Jones of FTI Consulting, Inc. will address the claims and conclusions regarding the operations and economics of petroleum products markets made by certain intervenor witnesses in their direct testimony. Mr. Jones will also address claims made by intervenor witnesses regarding the impacts of Laurel's reversal on wholesalers, retailers and consumers.
- Mr. Kenneth M. Stern of FTI Consulting, Inc. will address the claims and conclusions regarding refinery operations and economics made by certain intervenor witnesses in their direct testimony. Mr. Stern's testimony will specifically focus on the claims by

certain intervenor witnesses that Laurel's proposed reversal will negatively impact East Coast refineries.

- Mr. Glen R. Thomas of GT Power Group LLC will address the claims and conclusions of Robert A. Rosenthal, Indicated Parties Statement No. 3, regarding Laurel's certificate of public convenience and the standard of review to be applied to Laurel's proposed reversal.
- Mr. Andrew N. Kleit of Nathan Associates, Inc. will address the claims and conclusions of certain intervenor witnesses regarding competition in the petroleum products market generally and in Pennsylvania specifically.
- Mr. Mark Hereth of Process Performance Improvement Consultants, LLC will address the claims and conclusions of certain intervenors regarding the applicable statutes and regulations governing hazardous liquids pipeline safety, and PHMSA's role and procedures regarding pipeline reversals. Mr. Hereth will further testify as to how Laurel's proposed compliance steps comply with PHMSA requirements, and how PHMSA will oversee Laurel's compliance with pipeline safety obligations.

Laurel reserves the right to identify and present additional witnesses in this proceeding.

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
