**MONROE ENERGY LLC'S MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO COMPLY WITH ORDER COMPELLING RESPONSE
TO LAUREL SET III DISCOVERY**

TO: ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE ERANDA VERO

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, Monroe Energy, LLC, (Monroe Energy) respectfully requests Your Honor grant Monroe Energy an additional six days to comply with the October 10, 2017 Order (Order) compelling Monroe Energy to produce copies of all documents in possession of a non-party created since 2012 related to the sale of Monroe's refined petroleum products. Monroe Energy submits that good cause exists for this extension.

The Order requires Monroe Energy to provide the responses by tomorrow, Thursday, October 19, 2017. However, Monroe Energy's counsel, Hawke, McKeon and Sniscak, LLP did not provide Monroe Energy a copy of the order until today, Wednesday, October 18, 2017 because counsel, Ms. Snyder, to whom the order was addressed was out of the office from October 9 through October 18, and due to a staffing mistake, the Order was not provided to Mr. Stewart, counsel who remained in the office. Instead, the Order was placed in Ms. Snyder's mail pile and was unopened until her return to the office this morning. Because the Order was marked

confidential, it was not e-served, and thus counsel was otherwise unaware of the Order's existence.

While Monroe Energy diligently began the process of responding to the request once it received the Order today, due to the nature of the search required, it will be unable to complete the search and produce the required documents by tomorrow. Accordingly, Monroe Energy respectfully requests an extension to comply with the Order until Wednesday, October 25, 2017.

Counsel for Monroe Energy has contacted counsel for Laurel, and Laurel opposes the relief requested. However, Monroe Energy submits that Laurel will not be prejudiced because even if Monroe Energy complied with the Order and served its discovery responses on Thursday, October 19, 2017, Laurel would have less than 24 hours to try to incorporate any responses received into its testimony. Subject to the Commission and Your Honor's evidentiary rules, Laurel can use documents received pursuant to the Order at trial, and thus is not prejudiced by the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, Monroe Energy respectfully requests Your Honor extend the time for Monroe Energy to comply with the Order until Wednesday, October 25, 2017.
