this project is intended for.

cleared land needed for the proposed lines would put an undue burden on any farmer. Allowing for

eminent domain of not only a man's home but also taking away a large portion of the land he has to

earn a living on is dehumanizing. Our cows will also be in danger from stray voltage. No farmer benefits

from this project.

In conclusion the project that Transource wants to complete will cause more harm than good. This

project will not bring jobs into our community, but as mentioned above will hurt our hard working

farmers. The power lines will devalue properties, and may prevent many homes from being sold in the

future. Those that will be using the power lines are expected to save less than \$2 a year. Transource is

the only party that will benefit from this project.
