- 3. I urge you to deny any applications from Transource Independence Energy Connection (IEC) to construct any new right-of -way High Voltage, High Tension Transmission lines in Franklin County. Construction of this transmission project would place a heavy liability on county services, public safety, and our roadways, causing increased tax burden on local residents and business owners. This project will negatively and irreversibly affect the landscape of our historic Community and deflate property valves of homes, farms and businesses. I am extremely concerned about the hazards of stray voltage; furthermore this type of high voltage power line has not been proven to be safe to reside near. In many cases the lines are 300 feet from homes. The Transource Independence Energy Connection Project has no positive benefit to our community and furthermore I request the judges visit the sites proposed and hold hearings in Franklin County. Please hear our community voice and reject this project.
