2. I am a resident of Franklin County. The transmission line is proposed to travel less than a mile, and within sight of, my family home.

I work in my family business, which is located on the same property.

3. As part of my family's business, The Herb Corner, I raise bees in hives. I do this to introduce these pollinators locally, to help plants and agriculture. In addition, I use the wax to make soaps and other articles. The EMF radiation from high voltage electric lines has a markedly adverse effect on bees and their life cycles. In addition, the spraying of herbicide and insecticide in the local area will be increased, since the vegetation underneath the transmission lines must be kept clear.

I also maintain an organice garden for produce to both sell and for my family's consumbtion. The previously mentioned spraying techniques would be detrimental for organic gardens. Because we also buy from local farmer's markets, we have an active interest in keeping our farmlands, orchards, and other agricultural entities intact.

As a life-long resident, I am an active hiker and camper, and enjoy other outdoor recreational acitivities.

The views and landscapes that I adore will be forever ruined, if this project is approved.

4. As a Certified Natural Health Practitioner and proponent for mainitaining a healthy natural environment, I am appalled at the above proposal and am asking that Transource be denied any right of ways through Franklin County that they are requesting. I live less than a mile from the proposed route, and I am very concerned about the adverse health effects from these high voltage power lines. I can cite article after article which show the detrimental effects on any living beings that are unlucky enough to have to spend time around these wires. I am also aware of aerial and other spraying of toxic insecticides that would need to be sprayed beneath these wires and that this could result in the death of my beehives and swarms. I have read studies citing that EMF radiation will harm pollinators, which are already stressed by mites. Pollinators are so important to the agriculture and gardening of this beautiful area. Our fruits, vegetables and grains feed humans and animals, and bees are vital to the

production of all! This man-made monstrosity, which is being proposed solely for profit and NOT for any necessity to anyone, is threatening to destroy what we hold dear.

WHEREFORE, Leah Markus respectfully requests that you say NOI to the application cited. I also respectfully request that public meetings be held locally, instead of in Harrisburg. Franklin County will stand together. Please vote no on this proposal, for the health and livelihood of all.
