2. My interest in this project is as: I operate my horseback riding/ lessons and summer camps. business on the property of 699 Frosty Hill Rd Airville, I farm with my Parents on this farm. I am a resident of Lower Chanceford township York County
3. The grounds for our protest of this proposal:
 - a. The electric no way benefits the citizens of York County
 - b. There are other options not explored, IE another line almost parallel to proposed line
 - c. This is making a huge negative impact on agriculture and preserved farm ground
 - d. The project has not proven that it is really needed.
 - e. By denying this project, everyone still has electric, no one will be without electric
 - f. By denying this project it will make a voice loud and clear that unnecessary projects will not be allowed in Pa
 - g. Pa residents should not be responsible for utilities in Maryland, Virginia and Washington DC
 - h. This will be devastating to prime farm ground and local businesses.
 - i. This will curtail the expansion for my children, grandchildren and future generations.

4. This directly affects me by:

- a. My students need trails to ride on and they will go elsewhere if they are not available.
- b. My liability insurance is already very high, it will go up and make the cost to provide riding lessons to my students too expensive to provide. It will put me out of business.
