This stable houses over 60 horses, Presently, a wonderful place to ride with lots of trails for our horses. It's a proven fact that they shoot off stray voltage. It's not safe to ride in areas where horses with metal shoes would get shocked. Many Amish buggies get shocked with the existing lines we have in this area as they ride down the roads. Southern York County is polluted with other lines of this type.

I hope you will consider that there are other options to fulfill the need Transource is requesting, there are underutilized towers existing practically parallel to the lines they want to install.
