





*Duquesne Light Company - 2018 Base Rate Increase Case
Docket No. R-2018-3000124*

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) has scheduled public input hearings to accept customer comment on the request of Duquesne Light Company (Duquesne Light) to increase its annual distribution operating revenues by \$133.8 million, of which approximately \$52.2 million of revenues are currently recovered through surcharges. If Duquesne Light's proposals are adopted, its net distribution revenue would increase by approximately \$81.6 million. Customers of Duquesne Light are invited to provide their comments on the Company's request for the public record, which the Commission will consider in its decision.
