### AFFIDAVIT OF MATTHEW GORDON

Matthew Gordon states as follows:

- 1. My name is Matthew Gordon. I am employed by Sunoco Pipeline L.P. ("SPLP") and currently serve as the Senior Director for the Mariner East 2 and 2X pipeline project.
- 2. My July 3, 2018 affidavit was previously submitted in response to paragraph 7 of the Opinion and Order issued on June 15, 2018 (the "Order") by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") to identify the construction segments of the Mariner East 2 and 2X pipelines in West Whiteland Township for which the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP") has issued all required permissions for construction.
- 3. This affidavit clarifies and supplements my earlier affidavit to identify the separate and independent construction segments that DEP has approved.
- 4. Attached as Exhibits 1 and 2 are aerial maps that identify each construction segment by the work areas for the Mariner East 2 and 2X pipelines in West Whiteland

Township. DEP has approved construction in all work areas shown in green on the maps. SPLP needs additional approvals from DEP for the areas shown in red on the maps.




Work Areas in West Whiteland Township
