Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code S 5.94, the Laborers' International Union of North America, Local 57 ("LIUNA" or "Petitioner"), respectfully requests that Honorable Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Pell and the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Brady grant this Petition for Leave to Withdraw LIUNA's Petition to Intervene.
