**PETITION OF LABORERS INTERNATIONAL UNION OF NORTH AMERICA,
LOCAL 57 FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW INTERVENTION**

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code S 5.94, the Laborers' International Union of North America, Local 57 ("LIUNA" or "Petitioner"), respectfully requests that Honorable Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Pell and the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Brady grant this Petition for Leave to Withdraw LIUNA's Petition to Intervene. In support thereof, LIUNA states as follows:

1. On March 29, 2018, PECO Energy Company ("PECO") initiated this base rate proceeding by the filing of Tariff Electric—Pa. PUC No. 6. By Order entered on April 19, 2018, the Commission suspended the base rate filing for investigation until December 28, 2018.
2. On May 18, 2018, LIUNA filed both a Petition to Intervene and a Prehearing Memorandum.
3. As the Petition was not opposed, LIUNA was permitted to intervene.
4. LIUNA and PECO reached an agreement which resolves LIUNA's interests in this matter.
5. Based on this agreement, LIUNA believes that the issues which would be of interest to LIUNA to pursue are being adequately satisfied. As such, LIUNA no longer wishes to incur the time and expense involved with being an active party to this case.

6. No party will be harmed by LIUNA's withdrawal from these proceedings.
7. Permitting a party to withdraw from a proceeding when it no longer wishes to pursue its claims is in the public interest because it promotes judicial economy and streamlines the processing of the case.

WHEREFORE, the LIUNA respectfully requests that the Honorable Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Pell and the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Brady grant this Petition for Leave to Withdraw the LIUNA's Petition to Intervene and permit LIUNA to withdraw its participation as an active party in this proceeding.


