TRANSOURCE PENNSYLVANIA, LLC AMENDMENT TO THE APPLICATION DOCKETED AT A-2017-2640195 AND A-2017-2640200

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES ELIZABETH H. BARNES AND ANDREW CALVELLI:

Transource Pennsylvania, LLC ("Transource PA") herby files this Amendment to its Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC Filed Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57

Subchapter G, for Approval of the Siting Construction of the 230 kV Transmission Line Associated with the Independence Energy Connection-East Project in Portions of York County, Pennsylvania and Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC Filed Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57, Subchapter G, for Approval of the Siting and Construction of the 230 kV Transmission Line Associated with the Independence Energy Connection – West Project in Portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, which were filed on December 27, 2017, at Docket Nos. A-2017-2640195 and A-2017-2640200 ("Siting Application"). This Amendment is being filed in compliance with the Fifth Prehearing Order issued by Administrative Law Judges Elizabeth H. Barnes and Andrew Calvelli (the "ALJs") on October 1, 2018. Transource PA amends the Siting Application as follows:

- 1. On May 15, 2018, Transource PA filed 133 Applications for Eminent Domain related to the Siting Application.
- 2. Since the filing of the Siting Application and Eminent Domain Applications, Transource PA has progressed in the engineering and design of the proposed transmission line. Specifically, Transource PA has completed parcel boundary surveys, making it possible to eliminate the need to cross certain properties that are no longer impacted by the right-of-way.
- 3. On September 12, 2018, Transource PA filed Petitions for Leave to Withdraw forty-eight of the previously filed Eminent Domain Applications. Eleven of the Eminent Domain Applications were withdrawn because the properties originally identified in the Eminent Domain Applications are no longer affected by the proposed right-of-way due to engineering modifications. Thirty-seven of the Eminent Domain Application were withdrawn because the property owner and Transource PA executed a voluntary option agreement subsequent to Transource PA filing the Eminent Domain Application.

- 4. On November 20, 2018, Transource PA filed Petitions for Leave to Withdraw five more of the previously filed Eminent Domain Applications. Three of the Eminent Domain Applications were withdrawn because the properties originally identified in the Eminent Domain Applications are no longer affected by the proposed right-of-way due to engineering modifications. Two of the Eminent Domain Applications were withdrawn because the property owner and Transource PA executed a voluntary agreement subsequent to Transource PA filing the Eminent Domain Application.
- 5. On October 1, 2018, the ALJs issued a Fifth Prehearing Order granting Transource PA's Petitions for Leave to Withdraw the Eminent Domain Applications. The ALJs also directed Transource PA to file an Amendment to the Siting Application pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.93 concurrently with its rebuttal testimony to reflect the proposed route adjustment.
- 6. The proposed route has not materially changed from the route that was originally proposed in the Siting Application. The proposed route is still within the original 1,000 foot corridor consisting of 500 feet on each side of the centerline. See 52 Pa. Code § 57.76.
- 7. Included as TPA Exhibit 1 hereto are four aerial mapbooks depicting the revised centerline. Updated ESRI aerial maps are being provided for the East and West line segments and should be substituted for the aerial maps that were provided as Appendix C to the Siting Application. In addition, the Company is providing NAIP aerial maps for the East and West line segments. NAIP aerial maps were not included with the original Siting Application. The Company is providing both ESRI and NAIP aerial maps because the NAIP is the most up-to-date aerial source available, but the ESRI aerial map provides a better viewing quality. Both map versions depict the same centerline route for the East and West, respectively.

8. Pursuant to the Fifth Prehearing Order, this Amendment does not enlarge the scope of the issues in the above-captioned proceeding. Further, pursuant to the Fifth Prehearing Order, this Amendment does not allow additional entities status as parties to this proceeding because the minor route adjustment does not affect any new entity that was not affected by the original route.

WHEREFORE, for these reasons, and pursuant to the Fifth Prehearing Order issued by Administrative Law Judges Elizabeth H. Barnes and Andrew Calvelli, Transource Pennsylvania, LLC respectfully amends the Siting Application docketed at Docket Nos. A-2017-2640195 and A-2017-2640200 as explained above.

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
