GENERAL INFORMATION

Lien certificates do not reflect credits that may exist on a corporate account.

This document is not to be confused with or used in lieu of a bulk sale clearance certificate, which must be obtained by completing REV-181, Application for Tax Clearance Certificate, and submitted to the department pursuant to 72 P.S. §1403.

TRANSFER OF CREDIT

A corporation taxpayer may satisfy a liened liability by transferring available credit within the account. To transfer available credit, the taxpayer must fax a request on company letterhead that is signed by an officer of the corporation to 717-705-6227.

To assign credit between entities, the taxpayer must complete REV-774, Assignment of Tax Credit, in duplicate and


