

- (a) Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, *et al.*, v. Duquesne Light Company (DLC) (**Exceptions**)
- (b) On 3/28/18, DLC filed Supplement No. 174 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 24 (Supplement No. 174) containing a proposed general increase in electric distribution rates. On 9/14/18, a Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement Stipulation was filed, which resolved all issues except one regarding Rider No. 16, which was reserved for decision. By Recommended Decision, issued on 10/18/18, ALJ Katrina L. Dunderdale recommended that the Settlement be approved, and the Rider No. 16 rates proposed by the Duquesne Industrial Intervenors (DII) be adopted. On 10/29/18, Duquesne and the DII filed Exceptions. Replies to Exceptions were filed on 11/5/18.
