
Secretary Chiavetta:

I am writing to support the above complaint's request that the PUC conduct a review of Sunoco's public awareness program. If the PUC determines that Sunoco is unwilling or unable to comply with applicable law, I ask that PUC provide a final Order directing Sunoco to cease operations of the ME1 and workaround pipeline as defined in the Complaint.

My husband, Alan Tompkins, and I own a home located at 1303 Barkway Lane in East Goshen Township, Chester County. We estimate our home is 0.28 mile from the ME1 pipeline, although we have not been able to find a map we can read. We are concerned about issues related to the safety of people like my husband and myself who live in close proximity to this pipeline because of the hazardous materials it would transport. As we understand it, the workaround pipeline would increase the volume of hazardous, highly volatile liquids being transported through areas of East Goshen near our home. Sunoco has raised our level of concern because of the limited amount of information that has been provided. Moreover, no information has been provided to address emergency procedures. This includes appropriate actions that should be taken by residents to ensure our safety in the event of a leak or rupture of a pipeline – or, indeed in the unfortunate event of an explosion.

Our concern is that Sunoco has not taken steps to ensure the safety of the pipeline, much less steps to ensure residents know the appropriate course of action. Therefore, we urge the PUC to insist that Sunoco adhere to all applicable laws, regulations, and procedures.

Thank you for providing this opportunity for residents living near the ME1 and workaround pipeline to comment.
