As you know I was not notified of the pre-hearing conference held on September 28, 2018 and therefor did not attend this meeting. I have written both Governor Wolf and Secretary Chlavetta of the miss-handling of this case. Some effort needs to be established to include customer input other than public hearings without the Judges present.

Finally Aqua,s rate reqpauest is totally unwarranted. Thirty three percent of Aqua Pennsylvania,s customers reside in the main division and pay higher rates than other divisions. Rates should be based on cost in a division, plus a reasonable profit. Drexel Hill residents pay the township for sewer services, there no Aqua Bill for sewer.
