Recently, a resident named Rebecca Britton in Uwchlan Township where I am 1 of 3 supervisors, informed me that she filed a formal complaint against Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. After reading her complaint against Sunoco, I felt compelled to write this letter of support for Mrs. Britton. To give you background on Mrs. Britton, she has been a fierce, dedicated advocate for the residents of Uwchlan Township for several years. She was invited to speak to PA Senators in Harrisburg by Senator Dinniman and Senator Rafferty.

An area of concern in Mrs. Britton's complaint that I would like to address is her **Argument K. Pipeline Right of Way Selection.** Uwchlan Township is a township with 19,000 residents and many employees. ETP and Sunoco have a poor safety record. Among other things, activities in a neighboring township (West Whiteland) has resulted in sinkholes, with the latest reported on Sunday, January 20, 2019. I believe that locating this pipeline network in this densely populated area is unwise.
