# LAY WITNESSES OF INTERVENOR THE DOWNINGTOWN AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Pursuant to the Prehearing Order dated August 2, 2019, Intervenor the Downingtown Area School District, Chester County, Pennsylvania ("the School District") provides this list of lay witness, names, addresses and brief summaries of the subject matter to which they are expected to testify at the hearing scheduled for October 23 and October 24, 2019, and respectfully submits as follows:

# A. Emilie Lonardi, Ph.D., Superintendent of the Downingtown Area School District, 540 Trestle Place, Downingtown, PA 19335 - (610)-269-8460.

Dr. Lonardi is expected to testify about the composition of the School District, its mission, its schools, the schools' physical layout and the communities it serves. Dr. Lonardi will discuss the proximities of at least five Schools to the Mariner East 1 ("ME1") pipeline and/or a work-around 12-inch diameter pipeline that circumvents stopped construction on the Mariner East 2 ("ME2") and Mariner East 2X (ME2X) ("the ME Pipelines"). Dr. Lonardi is also expected to address the School District's practical concerns relating to schools being within the "blast zone", its concern with a Sunoco valve station along Dorlan Mill Road, in Upper Uwchlan Township, which is directly across the street from the Shamona Creek Elementary School and the Marsh Creek 6<sup>th</sup>

Grade Center, and risks of harm resulting from an automobile collision, leak or other failure of the valve station. Dr. Lonardi is expected to testify to the School District's desire for line inspection and geophysical testing, disclosure of those inspection and testing results, cessation of pipeline operations if testing demonstrate that corrective actions are necessary; mass early warning notification system at all potentially affected School District Schools which would provide immediately notice of a leak, potential explosion or other failure in the pipeline system; the benefits of School District-specific public education or awareness plan designed to inform and education the students, families and School District Staff on proper and effective disaster prevention and response, and the relocation of the valve station currently on Dorlan Mill Road.

# B. Mr. Thomas Mulvey, Principal, Marsh Creek Sixth Grade Center, 489 Dorlan Mill Road, Downingtown, PA 19335 - (610)-646-0081.

Mr. Mulvey is expected to testify, without repetition to the testimony of Dr. Lonardi, the concerns surrounding the valve station along Dorlan Mill Road, in Upper Uwchlan Township, which is directly across the street from the Shamona Creek Elementary School and the Marsh Creek Sixth Grade Center.

# C. Tim Hubbard, Chief Security Officer, reporting to Office of the Superintendent, Downingtown Area School District, 540 Trestle Place, Downingtown, PA 19335 - (610)-269-8460.

Mr. Hubbard is expected to testify to emergency management considerations particular to events affecting elementary and secondary schools and in support of the concerns identified by Dr. Lonardi and Mr. Mulvey. Mr. Hubbard will discuss response protocols, how they affect the surrounding communities, the advantages for early detection, notification, coordination, responses for special needs populations (such as schools) and education specific to events unique to the risks posed by the Sunoco Pipelines.
