- 3. The work is proposed as part of the Butler Pike Sinkhole Remediation Project which is headed by the Montgomery County Roads and Bridges in collaboration with Montgomery County Transportation Authority. Montgomery County Roads and Bridges, a County of the Second Class A, is the applicant with granted power to construct and maintain highways within the County of Montgomery under the provisions of the Second Class County Code. The Montgomery County Transportation Authority is organized under the Municipality Authorities Act and has the power to acquire right-of-way needed for highway construction and to convey property acquired thereunder to a municipality.
- 4. By this application, approval is sought to construct sinkhole prevention measures and reconstruct the road and various utilities in the area of the Norfolk Southern (NS) Butler Pike overpass AAR#532-100-Y (location map attached). The existing crossing includes two separate tracks owned and operated by NS that cross Butler Pike on a stone and concrete span bridge owned by NS. The project will include the following work by the County on Butler Pike in the County Right of way adjacent to the crossing:
 - Low mobility grouting (10'-50' below top of road) to fill in any voids and harden

underlying subgrade

- Reconstruction of Butler Pike underneath the bridge.
- Installation of drainage pipe in Butler Pike to carry stormwater.
- The installation of a new concrete box culvert just south of the crossing. The box culvert carries offsite and NS runoff that flows in a drainage swale within the NS right of way.

In order to best protect the road from further undermining the County would like to complete the following work within NS right of way:

- Low mobility grouting (10'-50' below top of road) to fill in any voids and harden underlying subgrade in the channel 35' upstream and downstream of the culvert.
- Stream hardening in the channel 35' upstream and downstream of the culvert.

There are several utilities under Butler Pike within the County right of way. The following utilities will replace their underground facilities during this construction contract:

- Texas Eastern 8" and 12" Main
- Whitemarsh Sewer Authority 12" Main
- Verizon drop existing duct bank to go under proposed culvert
- Aqua PA replace existing 12" Main

As-built plans to be provided at the conclusion of construction. Currently, Butler Pike is closed at this bridge crossing. The project proposes to maintain the two-way traffic through the crossing and improve the surrounding subgrade conditions. Vertical clearance of this crossing will not be altered in the reconstruction of the drainage culvert and roadway.

- 6. A traffic count of the highway crossing is not possible as the road is currently closed. Projecting volumes based on a PennDOT traffic count from 2018, results in an estimated 30,000 vehicles using the highway at the crossing over a three day period.
- 7. The anticipated cost for the overall Butler Pike Sinkhole Remediation project is \$1,800,000. The project is being funded by Montgomery County.
- 8. Sinkholes cause the road to buckle and lose support putting the travelling public at risk. Pressure of the roadway coming down on the utilities or the removal of the support soil can cause utilities to bend and potentially break, exacerbating the already tenuous situation. This project is necessary to create a stable base for both Butler Pike to safely carry vehicular and pedestrian traffic and the underlying utilities to have minimal underground movement.
- 9. Multiple field meetings and office meetings have occurred to discuss this situation with all parties.




