Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) received a formal complaint filed by the Philadelphia Industrial and Commercial Gas Users Group (“PICGUG”) in the above-captioned matter. On April 16, 2020, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) entered an Order initiating an investigation of PGW’s rate increase request. Consistent with Commission practice, all complaints will be consolidated in that proceeding. Accordingly, with respect to the complaints that have been filed, and any complaints hereafter filed, PGW, in lieu of filing answers thereto, will rely upon 52 Pa. Code § 5.61(d), which provides:

For complaints which are docketed with Commission-instituted rate proceedings, an answer may be filed within 10 days of date of service. However, an answer is not required, except as may be directed by the Commission or the presiding officer.

If the Commission or presiding officers direct that answers should be filed to any complaints, we request that PGW be provided 10 days from the date of such directive to file answers to such complaints.
