**PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS’ MOTION
FOR ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE***

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.22, Pa. B.A.R. 301(a) and Pa. R.C.P. 1012.1(d)(1) Sarah C. Stoner, of Eckert Seamans Cherin & Mellott, LLC moves for the admission *pro hac vice* of Craig Berry, Esquire to appear on behalf of Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) in this proceeding.

1. In support of this motion, a Verified Statement of Sarah C. Stoner, Esquire is attached hereto as Exhibit A and a Verified Statement of Craig Berry, Esquire is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

¹ 204 Pa. Code §§ 81.504, 81.505(c). IOLTA Board Staff confirmed on April 21, 2020, that attorneys that are only appearing in administrative agency hearings do not need to complete the *pro hac vice* application or pay the *pro hac vice* fee to the IOLTA Board.

5. PGW has requested that Mr. Craig Berry be admitted to represent PGW in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully move that Craig Berry, Esquire be admitted to appear *pro hac vice* on behalf of PGW in this proceeding.


7. If granted *pro hac vice* admission, I will comply with and be bound by the applicable statutes, case law and procedural rules of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission
