# PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF CALPINE RETAIL HOLDINGS, LLC

#### TO THE HONORABLE ERANDA VERO

Pursuant to the Prehearing Conference Order dated April 21, 2020, in the above-captioned proceeding and Sections 5.221 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PUC" or "Commission") Regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.221, Calpine Retail Holdings, LLC (together with its operating subsidiaries, "Calpine") hereby files this Prehearing Conference Memorandum.

#### I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- 1. On March 13, 2020, PECO Energy Company ("PECO") petitioned the Commission for approval of the Company's fifth Default Service Program ("DSP V").
  - 2. On April 14, 2020, Calpine petitioned to intervene in this proceeding.
- 3. Calpine is a provider of competitive electric services and as such is directly affected by the default service programs maintained by PECO and other electric utilities.
