Please be advised that Tri-Co Connections, LLC ("Tri-Co") acknowledges the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PUC") request for COVID-19 utility customer service, billing, and public outreach information in its May 29, 2020 Secretarial Letter issued in the above-referenced docket. Tri-Co is not yet providing PUC-jurisdictional voice services. However, Tri-Co has taken steps to expand non-jurisdictional broadband services in its rural service territory due, in part, to the pressing needs of rural consumers for efficient broadband and data service to facilitate work from home, study from home, telehealth, *etc.* Tri-Co plans to offer PUC-jurisdictional services later this year, and, upon offering those services, will engage in the necessary and appropriate consumer outreach, education, and billing procedures as envisioned in the PUC's May 29, 2020 Secretarial Letter.
