**MOTION OF VICE CHAIRMAN DAVID W. SWEET**

Before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission are the Exceptions of Sunoco Pipeline, L.P., (Sunoco) to the Initial Decision (I.D. or Initial Decision) of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Elizabeth H. Barnes. The Initial Decision granted in part and denied, in part, the Formal Complaint (Complaint) filed by Mr. Baker on August 10, 2018. I agree with the Staff recommendation to grant in part, and deny in part, the Company's Exceptions, adopt the Initial Decision of ALJ Barnes, as modified, and grant the Complaint, in part, and deny it, in part, with one modification. The Initial Decision was issued prior to the beginning of the ongoing pandemic and it directs Sunoco to contact the Lower Frankford Township Supervisors and Cumberland County Commissioners to schedule and appear at a public awareness hearing in Cumberland County.

Due to the current pandemic, the hearing should be held in compliance with guidelines from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Center for Disease Control, and may be held virtually as long as it is still open to public participation and viewing.

THEREFORE,  
I MOVE:

1. That the Staff Recommendation is modified by permitting the public awareness hearing ordered to be held in Cumberland County to be conducted virtually as long as it remains open to public participation and viewing.
2. That the Commission's Office of Special Assistants draft an appropriate order consistent with this Motion.
