Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On September 30, 2020, PECO Energy Company ("PECO or the Company") filed Original Tariff Gas- Pa. P.U.C. No. 4 ("Tariff No. 4") containing proposed changes in rates, rules and regulations for gas distribution service. The proposed rates are designed to produce an Increase in the Company's annual distribution revenue of approximately \$68.7 million based on a fully projected future test year ending June 30, 2022. Tariff No. 4 bears a proposed effective date of November 29, 2020.

On October 29, 2020, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Issued an Order at Docket No. R-2020-3018929 initiating an investigation of the rates, rules and regulations set forth in Tariff No. 4 and, thereby, suspending Tariff No. 4 by operation of law until June 30, 2021, unless otherwise directed by Order of the Commission. The Commission's Order also directed the Company to file a suspension supplement in the form provided as an attachment to that Order.

Therefore, in compliance with the Commission's September 30, 2020 Order, PECO submits for filing with the Commission the enclosed Supplement No. 1 to Tariff Gas No. 4 to reflect the suspension of Tariff No. 4 until June 30, 2021.

As per the stay-at-home orders issued by the Governor and Philadelphia's Mayor, all PECO attorneys and key support staff are working remotely until these restrictions are lifted. Accordingly, PECO will not have its usual access to photocopying and U.S. mail, among other services. PECO is filing this by e-filing and requests that all communications with PECO, likewise, be transmitted by email.
