

PETITION TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES, the Commission on Economic Opportunity (CEO), by and through counsel, Joseph L. Vullo, Esquire, and petitions to intervene in the above-captioned matter averring as follows:

1. The Petitioner, Commission on Economic Opportunity, is a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with its principal office located at 165 Amber Lane, P.O. Box 1127, Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, 18703-1127. CEO's telephone number is (570) 826-0510.

2. CEO is an advocate for its clients - the low-income population of Luzerne County - and has been directly involved in assuring that low-income persons' utility costs are contained through counseling, advice, payment assistance and energy conservation measures.

3. CEO seeks permission to intervene in PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's Petition for Approval of Act 129 Phase IV Energy Efficiency & Conservation Plan filed with the Commission.

4. PPL Electric Utilities Corporation serves customers in numerous counties including Luzerne County. Additionally, CEO is a customer of PPL Electric.

5. CEO seeks permission to intervene in this matter to address in large part the portion of the Company's Plan that concerns low-income customers. CEO reserves the right to address other parts of the Company's plan.

6. CEO's participation as an active party in this proceeding is required to protect its substantial interests and the substantial interests of the low income citizens it represents in ensuring that they receive the energy consumption benefits as required under Act 129. Accordingly, CEO's participation in this proceeding will serve the public interest.

7. Because CEO represents low-income citizens in Luzerne County, the interests of its clients are not being protected by any other party to this action.

POSITIONS

8. CEO reserves the right to address all portions of the Company's Plan, but its main purpose is to address that portion of the Plan that addresses low-income customers.

9. There is a substantial public interest in ensuring that low-income customers receive the consumption reduction benefits as required under Act 129 and under the Commission Phase IV Implementation Order.

10. CEO has been an active participant in this Company's prior requests for rate increases and other proceedings filed by this Company with the PUC. CEO was also an active party in the Commission's Phase IV Implementation and this Company's Phase III proceeding.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the Commission on Economic Opportunity respectfully requests that the Commission:

1. Receive for filing and docket this Petition to Intervene in order that CEO be a party to such proceedings and be placed on all service lists.

2. Grant to CEO active party status with the right to participate in all proceedings relative to this matter.




