

**COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY'S
PREHEARING MEMORANDUM**

I. HISTORY

The Commission on Economic Opportunity (CEO) intervened in this matter by Petition to Intervene filed on December 16, 2020. CEO is a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with its principal office located in Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania. CEO is an advocate for its clients - the low-income population of Luzerne County - and has been directly involved in assuring that low-income persons' utility costs are contained through counseling, advice, payment assistance and energy conservation measures. CEO has intervened in prior matters before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for the purpose of addressing a company's universal service programs and Act 129 Plans. CEO intervened in this particular matter to examine the Company's proposed Plan, particularly the low-income component of that Plan. CEO reserves the right to address other issues raised by the Company's Plan.

II. ISSUES TO BE PRESENTED BY CEO

1. CEO reserves the right to address all portions of the Company's Plan, but its main purpose is to address those portions of the Plan that address low-income customers.
2. Whether the Company's Plan serves the substantial public interest in ensuring that low-income customers receive the consumption reduction benefits as required under Act 129 and the

Phase IV Implementation Order.

3. Such other additional issues as may arise during the discovery process.

III. WITNESSES

CEO will present the testimony of Eugene M. Brady, Executive Director of CEO, to address the issues above-described.


IV. PROPOSED SCHEDULE


