GENERAL SERVICE – RATE GS (Page No. 83)

Changed the customer charges and delivery charges effective July 1, 2021, as follows. For Residential Customers, the customer charge increases from \$14.10 to \$14.45 and delivery charge increases from \$0.68642 to \$0.70318. For Public Housing customers, the customer charge increases from \$14.10 to \$14.45 and the delivery charge increases from \$0.59444 to \$0.61783. For Commercial Customers, the customer charge increases from \$24.00 to \$24.60 and the delivery charge increases from \$0.49570 to \$0.50488. For Industrial Customers, the customer charge increases from \$71.80 to \$73.60 and the delivery charge increases from \$0.48825 to \$0.49951.

MUNICIPAL SERVICES – RATE MS (Page No. 87)

Effective July 1, 2021, the customer charge increases from \$24.00 to \$24.60 and the delivery charge increases from \$0.44159 to \$0.45596.

PHILADELPHIA HOUSING AUTHORITY SERVICE – RATE PHA (Page No. 90)

Effective July 1, 2021, the customer charge increases from \$24.00 to \$24.60 and the delivery charge increases from \$0.51393 to \$0.52623.

AVAILABILITY

Available for any purpose where the Company's distribution mains adjacent to the proposed Gas Service location are, or can economically be made, suitable to supply the quantities of Gas or Transportation Services required. Not available for back-up service, refer to Rate BUS.

AVAILABILITY

Available to properties owned or occupied by the City of Philadelphia or the Board of Education, or any of their respective agencies or instrumentalities, for any type of Gas Service, unless purchased for resale to others, and where the Company's distribution mains adjacent to the proposed Gas Service locations are, or can economically be made, suitable to supply the quantities of Gas required; provided, however, that the rate shall not be available to Commercial Tenants of any such property.

PHILADELPHIA HOUSING AUTHORITY SERVICE - RATE PHA

Rate: Applicable to all Retail Sales Service or Transportation Services rendered pursuant to this Rate Schedule on or after July 1, 2021.

(C)AVAILABILITY

Available for all Gas usage in multiple dwelling Residential buildings containing 10 or more dwelling units, owned and operated by the Philadelphia Housing Authority, where cooking shall be performed exclusively with Gas and where Gas Service shall be supplied through one or more single point metering arrangements at locations where the Company's distribution mains adjacent to the proposed Gas Service locations are, or can economically be made, suitable to supply the quantities of Gas required.

This rate is also available for all Gas usage in single and multiple dwelling Residential buildings, containing less than 10 dwelling units, provided, and only so long as, Gas is used exclusively for cooking, water heating and space heating for all such Residential buildings owned and operated by the Philadelphia Housing Authority, except (a) buildings operated by the Philadelphia Housing Authority, prior to the original effective date of this rate (January 1, 1969), and (b) buildings for which, in the judgment of the Company, such Gas Service cannot be provided economically.
