Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

By Commission Order entered December 3, 2020 in the above-captioned rate case proceeding, the Commission approved the Joint Petition for Settlement submitted by the Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (“PWSA”), the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”), the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”), the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”), Pittsburgh United (“United”) and the City of Pittsburgh. Pursuant to Section III.F.7.c.iii of the Joint Petition for Settlement, PWSA agreed to “file a Petition for a proposed line repair and conservation program within one year after entry of the Commission’s final order.”

The purpose of this letter is to request a one-month extension of time to January 3, 2022 to file the Petition. Consistent with the terms of the Joint Petition for Settlement, PWSA has been working to develop a proposal for submission to the Commission and has been collaborating with members of its Low Income Assistance Advisory Committee (“LIAAC”). While good progress has occurred, PWSA has determined that a short extension of time to make the filing will enable it to continue its on-going collaborative discussions and to consider the feedback received to date which will enable it to present a more robust petition for the Commission’s consideration. **PWSA is authorized to represent that none of the parties referenced above object to this requested extension of time.**

For all these reasons, PWSA requests that the Commission grant it an extension of time to file a proposed line repair and conservation program petition on or before January 3, 2022.
