Notice of Change in Ownership**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

This letter serves as notice to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission of a change in ownership of Provident Energy Consulting LLC (“Provident”) that occurred on June 1, 2022.

Effective June 1, 2022, Building Systems Holdings, LLC, a North Dakota limited liability company (“BSH”), has acquired all of the issued and outstanding equity interests of Provident (the “Transaction”). Joseph S. Solomon (“Solomon”), the previous owner of Provident, determined that it was in the best interest of Provident, its customers, and its stakeholders to enter the Transaction as it allows for greater financial and strategic opportunities to better meet the needs of its customers, while continuing to execute its core business strategy.

In connection with the Transaction, Provident became a wholly-owned subsidiary of BSH. BSH has determined that it is in the best interest of Provident to appoint new officers of Provident to manage its affairs and better serve its customers. The following will hold the respective office next to each of their names as set forth below:

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Solomon will continue to be involved in Provident's operations as a consultant pursuant to a consulting agreement entered into in connection with the Transaction. Additionally, customer relationships will not be affected as each of Provident's former employees will continue to serve its customers in a similar role following the Transaction.

BSH and Provident are committed to delivering services marked by consistency and quality. Their goal is to make this a seamless transition, including the continued service of Provident's customers in Pennsylvania. The Transaction will have no impact on Provident's services in Pennsylvania. Provident will continue to hold its electric generation supplier license and natural gas supplier license and serve its customers in Pennsylvania under the same terms and conditions, and in the same manner, as conducted prior to the Transaction. There will be no adverse impacts to the customers whatsoever – no customer contracts will be affected, and customers will not experience any change in the terms, conditions, or quality of their service. Nor will the change in ownership affect the financial and technical capability of Provident to serve customers in Pennsylvania.




