Dear Ms. Hirakis:

By Order entered December 8, 2022, the Commission authorized Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (the Company) to file tariff supplements reflecting the rates set forth in the Company's proposed compliance tariff attached to the Joint Petition for Partial Settlement as Appendix A and the Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement as Appendix B in the above docketed rate investigation, so as to produce an annual increase in base rate operating revenues not to exceed \$44.5 million. On December 9, 2022, the Company filed Supplement No. 351 to Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 to become effective December 17, 2022, in compliance with the Order. On December 22, 2022, the Company filed Supplement No. 354 to Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 to become effective January 1, 2023 to set the first year Energy Efficiency (Rider EE) rate of the Company's three-year pilot program in compliance with the Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplements are effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
