(a) Petition of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL) for Approval of Tariff Modifications and Waivers of Regulations Necessary to Implement its Energy Resources Management Plan **(Petitions for Interlocutory Review and Answers to Material Questions)**

(b) On September 20, 2019, Petitions for Interlocutory Review and Answers to Material Questions were filed by OCA, the NRDC and SUNRUN at the above-captioned docket. The next scheduled public meeting fell beyond the 30-day statutory deadline for Commission action on the petitions. Therefore, the Commission engaged in a notational voting process on October 17, 2019, through which it denied the Petitions as premature and returned the proceeding to the presiding officer for hearing and development of the record. The resulting Opinion and Order was entered on October 17, 2019.
