
On February 1, 2023, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, and West Penn Power Company (collectively the ‘Companies’) filed the results of their Request for Proposals (RFP) Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) Solicitation for Renewable Energy and associated Solar Photovoltaic Alternative Energy Credits (SPAECs) Procurement. The Companies’ filing is submitted in accordance with their Joint Petition at Docket Nos. P-2021-3030012, P-2021-3030013, P-2021-3030014, and P-2021-3030021 pursuant to the Commission’s Order entered August 4, 2022.

The 2023 PPA solicitation sought procurement of between 7 and 20 MW of total capacity and for a term of between 4 and 10 years. The Companies request that the Commission approve the bid results for the 2023 PPA by close of business on February 10, 2023.

A further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, as the bid results from the 2023 PPA Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the procedures approved by the Commission. Therefore, we direct the Companies to disclose the results of the 2023 SPAEC Solicitation in accordance with the Commission’s Secretarial Letter in Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and Creation of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model, issued October 12, 2010, at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
