Proposal for the Spring 2023 GSR-1 Full Requirements and Block RFP

Dear Ms. Colaizzi:

On April 18, 2023, UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI) filed the results of its Request for Proposals (RFP) Process and Rules for the Spring 2023 Solicitation for provider of last resort service. The filing includes proposed bid results for a 12- and 24-month full requirements power RFP for Residential and Small Commercial and Industrial customers who receive default service from UGI during the period of June 1, 2023 through May 31, 2025. The filing also includes proposed bid results for a Block power RFP for Residential and Small Commercial and Industrial customers who receive default service from UGI during the 6-month period June 1, 2023 through November 30, 2023.

This filing was submitted in accordance with UGI's Default Service Plan IV RFP Process and Rules filed on May 26, 2020, as part of a Joint Petition for Settlement. The RFP Process and Rules were approved as modified by the Settlement in the Commission's Order, entered January 14, 2021, at Docket No. P-2020-3019907.


UGI requests that the Commission approve the bid results of the Spring 2023 Solicitation on or before April 19, 2023.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the results of the Spring 2023 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules as approved by the Commission.
