Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Enclosed for filing are the executed **CONFIDENTIAL** Amendment Number One (“Amendment 1”), Amendment Number Two (“Amendment 2”), and Amendment Number Three (“Amendment 3”) to the Conservation Service Provider (“CSP”) Contract between PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) and the CSP selected to implement the Non-Residential Program under the Company’s Phase IV Energy Efficiency and Conservation (“EE&C”) Plan.

On April 15, 2021, PPL Electric filed the Non-Residential CSP Contract with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) with the documentation required under the Commission’s *Phase IV Implementation Order*.<sup>1</sup> On May 6, 2021, Commission staff approved the Non-Residential CSP Contract.

The purpose of the enclosed **CONFIDENTIAL** Amendment 1 and Amendment 2 is to amend, among other things, the retainage refund schedule. The purpose of the enclosed **CONFIDENTIAL** Amendment 3 is to amend, among other things, the performance-based compensation figures.
