Universal Incorporation of Damage Prevention Programs

Fundamental Change #1

Improvement requires universal integration of damage prevention programs

Need

There is no independent third-party entity that can objectively *verify* the existence of an DP program, *consult* on building one, and *monitor* compliance with that SMS.

Solution

GSS provides a low-cost, scalable solution to stakeholders that includes a standard, minimum set of policies and procedures they must abide by to become GSS Certified.

Need

Currently, there are no standardized measurements systems which support normalized comparisons across various entities, companies and stakeholders.


Solution

Most companies do not have the internal technology necessary to accomplish the goal, as it relates to elevated performance.


