

Enclosed please find an original and three copies of Williamsport Moving Company, Inc.'s Application for Emergency Temporary Authority. Please be advised that this Application is being filed due to the extended delay in issuance of the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Michael Schnierle in Williamsport's previously filed Application for authority to operate within Centre County which Initial Decision was issued on May 6, 2004. Exceptions and reply exceptions have been filed and a decision by the Commission is not expected in the near future.

Williamsport filed this Application in November 2002. This matter has been in litigation for approximately 1-1/2 years. Williamsport was granted authority by the Initial Decision of ALJ Schnierle in May 2004 although reply briefs were filed in October 2003. Williamsport is anticipating that no Commission decision will be issued prior to the main moving season which begins in May 2004. In order to take advantage of the 2004 summer moving season, Williamsport is compelled to file this application on an emergency basis for issuance of authority.



The following statement is made on behalf of Williamsport Moving Co. Inc., T/A Keystone Relocation. Robert J. McKernan, Jr., President of the company, has prepared this statement.

The equipment we will use to service customers in Centre County is the existing equipment in our fleet, approximately seven straight trucks, 2 tractor-trailers and 2 pack units.

At this time we do not have a permanent facility in Centre County. We are in the process of processing three individuals to work as temporary summer time employees. These summer employees will work with the full time professional Van Foreman that currently part of our team.

We have not had any problems with the Commission. The reason for this ETA is because the PUC has had my application for permanent authority since October 2002. Recently ALJ Schnierle wrote an initial decision in favor of our being granted the authority we had asked for.

But, given the appeal process, customers in Centre County will be denied an opportunity to use our service this summer unless this ETA is granted. I can be reached at 570-326-1727 if you wish to discuss any part of this application.

We will use the current rate structure we have filed with the commission. An attached copy is provided. No other rates are on file or under consideration by the Commission.
