ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Glose Moving & Storage, Inc. (Carrier), furnishes household goods in use services originating in Columbia County as thoroughly described in the order granting authority.

Carrier has filed the 2nd Revised Page 47-B to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54, on June 15, 2006.

Carrier proposes to increase its hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 6%. Carrier currently charges \$84.00 per hour and proposes an increase to \$89.00 per hour. The current hourly rates have been in effect since December 8, 2003.

Carrier has submitted a tariff and documentation, in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §23.67(c), for carriers of household goods in use, with gross annual intrastate revenues of less than \$200,000 and an operating ratio of not less than 93%.

ANALYSIS

In order to generate this revenue increase, Carrier proposes increases in its hourly charges. Carrier proposes to increase its 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge of \$84.00 per hour to \$89.00 per hour, which would be an increase of 6%.

CONCLUSION

We have determined that the increase is not an excessive amount based on the operating ratio. We believe that the increase will be sufficient to provide safe, dependable and continuous service to the public. The Carrier has no outstanding fines or assessment due; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That the 2nd Revised Page 47-B to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54, be approved to become effective on August 21, 2006.
