(b) Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. (Tristate) has filed 8th Revised Page 76 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 on March 14, 2007 and proposes a total increase in revenues of \$21,190 to cover increased wage and fringe benefits for carriers in Berks County. The current rates have been in effect since August 21, 2006. Tristate proposes to increase the hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 3.6%. The current hourly rate for Berks County is \$112 per hour. Tristate proposes increasing this rate to \$116 per hour. Glose Moving & Storage, Inc. and L & J Moving & Storage, Inc. are the affected carriers. Neither carrier has outstanding fines or delinquent assessments. Tristate has submitted documentation supporting the proposed increase indicating that it is necessary to cover the cost of operating. Employee wages and fringe benefits have increased by 3.5% from \$27.55 per hour in 2006 to \$28.52 per hour in 2007.

(c) The data compiled and submitted by the carrier supports this increase and the Bureau recommends that 8th Revised Page 76 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 be approved to become effective May 14, 2007.



ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. (Tristate) has filed the 8th Revised Page 76 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 on March 14, 2007 and proposes a total increase in revenues of \$21,190 to cover increased wage and fringe benefit expenses for carriers in Berks County. The current rates have been in effect since August 21, 2006.

Tristate proposes to increase the hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 3.6%. The current hourly rate for Berks County is \$112 per hour. Tristate proposes increasing this rate to \$116 per hour.

Glose Moving & Storage, Inc. and L & J Moving & Storage, Inc. are the affected carriers that are subject to the 8th Revised Page 76 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 for Berks County. Neither carrier has any outstanding fines or assessments.

Tristate has submitted a wage/fringe benefit and insurance cost study for Berks County in support of the proposed hourly increase indicating that the increase is necessary to cover the cost of operating. Employee wages and fringe benefits have increased by 3.5% from \$27.55 per hour in 2006 to \$28.52 per hour in 2007.

ANALYSIS

In order to generate this revenue increase, Tristate proposes to increase the 3 men and vehicle normal complement by 3.6% from a charge of \$112 per hour to \$116 per hour. We conclude that the data compiled and submitted by the carrier supports this increase.

CONCLUSION

We have determined that Tristate has submitted the documentary justification to support the proposed revenue increase of \$21,190 and that the increase is not an excessive amount based on the increase in operating expenses. We believe that the increase will be sufficient for the carriers to provide safe, dependable and continuous service to the public: THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That 8th Revised Page 76 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50 is approved to become effective May 14, 2007.
- 2. That a copy of this order be served upon Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc.
