INCREASE IN RATES**

(b) Glose Moving & Storage, Inc. (carrier) furnishes household goods in use services originating in Berks, Carbon, Chester, Columbia, Lehigh, Luzerne, and Schuylkill Counties as more thoroughly described in the order which grants authority at Docket No. A-00094076. Carrier has filed the 3rd Revised Page 46 and 3rd Revised Page 47 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54, on February 26, 2007. Carrier proposes to increase its hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 11.2%. Carrier currently charges \$80 per hour and proposes an increase to \$89 per hour (11.2%). The current rates have been in effect since May 28, 2001. Carrier has submitted a tariff and documentation, in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §23.67(c), for carriers of household goods in use, increasing gross annual intrastate revenues by less than 1%. Currently, the carrier has no outstanding fines or assessments.

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Glose Moving & Storage, Inc. (carrier) furnishes household goods in use services originating in Berks, Carbon, Chester, Columbia, Lehigh, Luzerne, and Schuylkill Counties as more thoroughly described in the order which grants authority at Docket No. A-00094076.

Carrier has filed the 3rd Revised Page 46 and 3rd Revised Page 47 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54, on February 26, 2007. Carrier proposes to increase its hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 11.2%. Carrier currently charges \$80 per hour and proposes an increase to \$89 per hour (11.2%). The current rates have been in effect since May 28, 2001.

Carrier has submitted a tariff and documentation, in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §23.67(c), for carriers of household goods in use, increasing gross annual intrastate revenues by less than 1%. Currently, the carrier has no outstanding fines or assessments.

ANALYSIS

In order to generate this revenue increase, carrier proposes to increase its hourly 3 men and vehicle normal complement charge by 11.2%. Carrier currently charges \$80 per hour and proposes an increase to \$89 per hour (11.2%). The carrier submitted a statement that the resulting increase in gross annual intrastate revenues will be less than 1%, and its operating ratio is not less than 93%. Currently, the carrier has no outstanding fines or assessments.


CONCLUSION

We have determined that Glose Moving & Storage, Inc., has submitted the documentary justification to support the proposed revenue increase and that the increase is not of an excessive amount based on the operating ratio. We conclude that the increase will be sufficient to provide safe, dependable and continuous service to the public:
THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the 3rd Revised Page 46 and 3rd Revised Page 47 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 54 are approved to become effective on April 30, 2007.
