Re: Duquesne Light Company – Results for the September 19, 2022, Request for Proposals

Dear Mr. Peoples:

On September 19, 2022, CRA International, Inc. d/b/a Charles River Associates filed Duquesne Light Company's (DLC) results of its DSP IX procurement process and rules for the September 2022 Solicitation for DLC's default service customers. The filing includes bid results for a Full Requirements RFP for the supply for residential, small commercial & industrial (C&I), and medium C&I customers who will receive default service from DLC within the period December 1, 2022, through November 30, 2024. All products were procured via declining clock auctions.

This filing was submitted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules that were approved as modified by the Commission's Order, entered January 14, 2021, at Docket No. P-2020-3019522. DLC requests that the Commission approve the bid results of the September 2022 Solicitation on or before September 21, 2022.

The supply for 12 and 24 months residential and small C&I customers was fully subscribed. The supply for medium C&I customers was undersubscribed and only three of the four available tranches were procured. Therefore, we direct DLC to enact its contingency plan regarding the medium C&I customer procurement in accordance with its default service plan. Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, regarding the 12 and 24 months residential and small C&I procurements since the results of the September 2022 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules as approved by the Commission.

Therefore, we direct DLC to disclose the results of this September 2022 Solicitation in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter in <u>Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and Creation of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model</u>, issued October 12, 2010, at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
