**AFFIDAVIT OF LARRY FINNICUM
REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH NOTICE REQUIREMENTS**

On this 25th day of April, 2024, before the undersigned Notary Public in and for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and County of Dauphin, personally appeared Larry Finnicum, who, being duly sworn according to law, deposes and says that he is the President and General Manager of Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. ("VWPA") and that:

1. A Prehearing Conference was held in this matter on March 27, 2024. On April 1, 2024, the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Emily I. DeVoe issued her Prehearing Order memorializing the agreements and rulings from the Prehearing Conference. At Page 5, the Prehearing Order states:

Further, I directed the Company to publish notice in the general readership section of a newspaper local to the service area at least two weeks prior to the scheduled hearings. The Company agreed to publicize the public input hearings on its website and social media. The Company agreed to work with the statutory advocates on the specific wording of the notice to be published.

2. On April 8, 2024, VWPA received a Notice of Public Input Hearings from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission regarding the above-referenced proceedings.

3. VWPA prepared a draft advertisement of the Public Input Hearings, which was circulated to the Office of Consumer Advocate ("OCA"), the Office of Small Business Advocate

(“OSBA”), the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”), and the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (“CAUSE-PA”) on April 9, 2024. OCA was the only party that provided comments. VWPA made most of the changes requested by OCA (the only change that was not made repeated information provided elsewhere in the advertisement).

4. On April 10, 2024, VWPA sent the advertisement for publication in the general readership section of several newspapers of general circulation in VWPA’s service area. Those newspapers agreed to run the advertisements on the dates indicated below.
